"Parallel Pattern"

Through the disobedience of Adam, <u>sin and death</u> entered into the world.

Who then is responsible for this sin and death?

We not only inherit Adam's guilt before God, but also the <u>desire</u> to break God's commands.

Romans 5:14 describes Adam as "a <u>pattern</u> of the one to come," namely, <u>Jesus Christ</u>.

Notice the parallels that are found between Adam and Jesus...

Rom. 5:15	ADAM:	The <u>Trespass</u>
	// JESUS:	The <u>Gift</u>
Rom. 5:15	ADAM:	Many have <u>died</u>
	// JESUS:	Many will <u>live</u>
Rom. 5:16	ADAM:	Judgment follows sin
	// JESUS:	Gift follows many <u>trespasses</u>
Rom. 5:17	ADAM:	Reign of death for all who break God's commands
	// JESUS:	Reign of life for all who <u>receive</u> God's grace
Rom. 5:18	ADAM:	The result is <u>condemnation</u> for all people
	// JESUS:	The result is justification for all people
Rom. 5:19	ADAM:	Through his <u>disobedience</u> , many made sinners
	// JESUS:	Through His <u>obedience</u> , many made righteous

For as in Adam all <u>die</u>, so in Christ all will be made <u>alive</u>.
