Why do Christians celebrate four weeks of Advent every December?

To <u>PREPARE</u> our lives for the coming of Jesus...*both* His first *and* His second advent.

A <u>MESSENGER</u> named John was sent by God to make people ready for Jesus' first coming.

MALACHI 3:1

"I will send My messenger, who will prepare the way before Me. Then suddenly the Lord you are seeking will come to His temple; the messenger of the covenant, whom you desire, will come," says the Lord Almighty.

The Word of God is the messenger we've received that tells us *both* of what Christ <u>HAS DONE</u> already *and* of what Christ <u>WILL DO</u> when He comes again.

As our messenger, God's Word ...

• <u>REFINES US</u> like silver that is precious to the One who owns it.

MALACHI 3:2-3
