“God Is At Work”
Acts 2:32-33

1) GOD IS AT WORK **IN OUR WORLD.**

At the highest point along the way, where the paths meet, she (Wisdom) takes her stand; beside the gate leading into the city, at the entrance, she (Wisdom) cries aloud: “To you, O people, I call out; I raise my voice to all mankind. Proverbs 8:3-4.

(Peter said), God has raised this Jesus to life, and we are all witnesses of it. Exalted to the right hand of God, he has received from the Father the promised Holy Spirit and has poured out what you now see and hear. Acts 2:32-33.

2) GOD IS AT WORK **IN YOU.**

When the people heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, “Brothers, what shall we do?”

Peter replied, “Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off—for all whom the Lord our God will call.” Acts 2:37-39
